



## Call for Scholarship Applications

### About Erasmus Mundus

The Erasmus Mundus programme aims at enhancing the quality of higher education and promotes the dialogue and understanding between people and cultures through mobility and academic cooperation. Action 2 Partnerships are the basis for enhancing academic cooperation and exchanges of students and academics, contributing to the socio-economic development of non-EU countries targeted by EU external cooperation policy.

### About EUSA\_ID

EUSA\_ID is a mobility programme offering study, training and research periods in Europe for **South African Master and PhD Candidates and staff** and provides **European PhD Candidates** with the opportunity to spend a research period in South Africa in the field of Development Studies at the respective partner universities. Altogether 84 mobilities (18 European, 66 South African) will be funded.

### Mobilities

#### Mobility South Africa to Europe (Master, PhD, staff)

All applicants must be South African nationals and can apply, if they belong to Target Group I or II (see [www.eusa-id.eu](http://www.eusa-id.eu)).

#### Mobility Europe to South Africa (PhD)

All applicants must be national of one of the eligible European countries and belong to either Target Group I or II (see [www.eusa-id.eu](http://www.eusa-id.eu)).

### Call for Applications and start of individual mobilities

- The 3rd call for applications of the EUSA\_ID partnership is open until 20th November 2015. The selection of candidates takes place in December, selection results are published in December as well. Follow-up communication with selected candidates will start immediately after the publication in the selection results.
- Mobility periods of selected candidates will start at the beginning of the academic year at the hosting institution.
